# Summer School "Rural development" Detailed information

# **Activities prior to the Summer School**

In the months before the summer school you are supposed to write a paper about rural development linked with your thesis or another project you are working on at the moment. The paper should be related to the application of economics, management and social sciences in rural development. The length of the paper is about 4 pages and it should be sent to <a href="wim.heijman@wur.nl">wim.heijman@wur.nl</a> or <a href="mailto:fenneke.brascamp@wur.nl">fenneke.brascamp@wur.nl</a> before June 1, 2009. In the following month you receive 3 papers from other students that need to be read through critically. During the Summer School the students who have read the specific papers of students give comments and suggestions on the paper of the student in question.

#### Summer School

The Summer School will cover six days in total. Every day a teacher will give a lecture about a specific topic that is related to rural development. In addition to the lectures, the students get the opportunity to present their paper, which will be discussed afterwards. Two students should be extra critically towards the presentation. These students will be the same as those who have read the paper beforehand. A schedule of the presentations will be hand out at the beginning of the week. Next to the presentations and the lectures, two excursions will be organized, this will cover one and a half day.

#### **Activities after the Summer School**

After the summer school, the student is expected to finish the paper and to take along all the received comments. All the papers will be collected again and will be published in the Summer School Proceedings as a tangible souvenir of the Wageningen Summer School on rural development.
